We are writing to share important updates related to Pre-Collegiate's Summer Academic Institute 2021 (SAI).

Due to COVID-19 restrictions that impact the UCCS campus, Pre-Collegiate will offer a hybrid Summer Academic Institute in June and July 2021. The Pre-Collegiate team has been working diligently to adapt our programming so that we can offer dual enrollment classes, academic and skill-building workshops, and opportunities for students during this time. Some programming will be conducted in-person, but most sessions will be offered remotely online.

- Workshops and Dual Enrollment Classes require an Academic Outreach Application. More
  information will be released after students complete the <u>2021 SAI Workshop Registration</u>. We
  will have an opportunity on May 8<sup>th</sup> after the <u>SAI Orientation</u> to assist you with the Academic
  Outreach Application if you are having difficulty.
- If you plan to participate during the summer, please keep in mind that you will be expected to attend every session and there will be no excused absences. Exceptions to this will be handled on a case-by-case basis.
- Any In-person components will require a <u>UCCS Wellness Check</u>. You will also be expected to
  follow all campus rules and guidelines regarding wearing of a face covering and adhering to
  physical distancing and area hygiene.

### SUMMER ACADEMIC INSTITUTE 2021 PROGRAMMING DESCRIPTIONS

### **EXPLORATION AND FUTURE VISIONS WORKSHOP**

• Grade: Rising Sophomores and newly admitted Pre-Collegiate Students

• Dates: Thursday, June 3 and Friday, June 4

• Times: 10:00am - 12:00pm

- Required for rising sophomores and newly admitted students. Must attend both sessions.
- **Delivery Method:** Zoom
- **Expectations**: Students can expect to spend an additional 2 hours working on assignments related to the Zoom components of this workshop.
- **Description**: In this live remote workshop, students will reflect on how their identities, interests, and skills may shape their academic and professional futures. With guidance from the Pre-Collegiate team, students will complete self-paced activities to explore potential future academic, personal, and career goals, and the steps they may need to take to get there.

#### MUSIC AND LYRICS WORKSHOP

- **Grade:** Rising Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors
- Dates: Wednesday, June 23 Friday, June 26
- **Times:** 9:00 am 11:00 am
- Recommended for all students, limited to 20 students. Must be able to attend all three sessions.
- **Delivery Method:** Zoom and Canvas
- Expectations: No additional time commitment outside of workshop hours.
- **Description**: This workshop will look at the best song lyrics from the past and present and discover what makes them great. It will give students an opportunity to write their own versions of songs and create new lyrics. There will also be an opportunity to present/perform their lyrics.

### MATH BRIDGE VIRTUAL WORKSHOP

- Grade: Rising Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors
- Dates: Monday, June 7 Friday, July 2, 2021
- **Times:** 9am 11am
- **Recommended** for all students
- **Delivery Method:** Zoom and Canvas
- Expectations: 1 Hour/Day M-F at your own pace.
- **Description**: Students will practice key math-based skills to strengthen their existing skillsets. Students will complete self-paced activities that will build their skills and will receive feedback from a Master Teacher in math. Students will develop a custom plan of action to prepare for college admissions tests that will help them work test prep into their busy schedules during the summer and academic year.

### SCHOLARSHIP WRITING & PRACTICE INTERVIEWS VIRTUAL WORKSHOP

- Grade: Rising Seniors only
- Dates: Monday, June 14 Friday, June 23
- **Times:** 9:30 am to 10:15am (Live)
- REQUIRED FOR ALL RISING SENIORS
- **Delivery Method:** Zoom and Canvas
- Expectations: Writing and research on your own time is a part of this workshop.
- Description: Students will use reflections on their experiences, identities, and background to
  create a draft of a personal essay to submit with scholarship or college applications. This
  workshop will address key components of writing such as mechanics, voice, and audience.
   Students who participate in the Scholarship Writing Workshop will receive feedback on their work
  from faculty members from the UCCS Department of English. Students will also have an

opportunity to receive a practice interview that would be applicable for scholarship or college admissions purposes.

- **Grade:** Rising Sophomores, Rising Juniors, and Rising Seniors
- Dates & Times: Tuesday, June 29 from 9:00 AM 12:30 PM or Wednesday, June 30 from 2:30 PM 6:00 PM (students choose their preferred date)
- STRONGLY RECOMMENDED FOR ALL STUDENTS
- **Delivery Method:** Zoom
- **Description**: Open to all students participating in the Summer Academic Institute. All sessions are the same on both days. Students will participate in breakout sessions on a variety of topics ranging from:
  - o Jobs connected to Pathways
  - o Information for student athletes pursuing their sport in college/professionally
  - Mental health
  - o School/work/life balance

### **DUAL ENROLLMENT**

During our modified Summer Academic Institute, UCCS Pre-Collegiate will offer a limited number of VIRTUAL dual enrollment courses to students who will be Juniors and Seniors during the 2021-2022 academic year. <u>Unfortunately, we are unable to offer dual enrollment to rising sophomores this summer.</u> Full communication about summer dual enrollment was originally sent to rising Juniors and rising Seniors on March 26th. UNITE – Rising 10<sup>th</sup> grade Engineering Program

Rising 10<sup>th</sup> grade students selected for the Engineering and Technology pathway, are invited to participate in a four-week engineering exploration program (June 7-July 2). This is an opportunity to explore different engineering fields and participate in both virtual and in-person hands-on learning experiences. The 4-week schedule is required for this program. Equipment pickup from UCCS is June 3 8:00-11:00am.

- 3 weeks Arduino Inventor's kits electrical engineering and coding projects (Virtual)
- 4 weeks of Code Combat Python Programming (Virtual)
- 2 weeks of Engineering Career Exploration (Virtual)
- 1 week (1/2 day) of Drone workshop (In-Person)
- 4 weeks of Math Bridge Let's work on those Foundational Math Skills (Virtual)
- ½ day Engineering Career and College student panel (Virtual)
  - \*NOTE: There will be a mandatory virtual orientation for the Unite program on May18 or May 20 at 5:30pm.

- Explorations & Future Visions Workshop is required for rising sophomores and other new Pre-Collegiate students.
- Scholarship Writing & Practice Interview Workshop is required for rising seniors.
- Unless indicated as required, dual enrollment, workshops, and summer virtual conference offerings **are optional** to students, but participation is strongly encouraged!
- All workshops are offered <u>at no cost to students.</u>
- TRANSPORTATION: Depending on your school district, transportation may be provided from specified locations to UCCS. Information will be released closer to June 2021.
- Rising Juniors and Rising Seniors, the link to the application for summer dual enrollment (due April 16) can be found <a href="https://example.com/here">here</a>. <a href="https://example.com/here">Be sure to read the information from March 26 before completing the application.

- Except for the in-person event on June 28<sup>th</sup> and Unite Engineering Drone workshop, programming will be offered online. Pre-Collegiate is optimistic about returning to partial inperson programming in Fall 2021.
